The receiving KU Leuven university campus and the student hostel “de kraal” are on the same site in Ostend (address: Zeedijk, 101, B-8400 Ostend, Belgium). This avoids costs and time-consuming transfers between the student hostel and the KU Leuven campus.

The cost for students staying at the hostel is about € 30,- per night per person (€ 180,- per student, according to the schedule as above). This includes 3 meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner. Bed sheets are included. Payment needs to be done in cash money (EURO) upon arrival. Students will receive an official cost note, mentioning: the name and address of the student, dates of stay and number of days, the amount paid in EURO, a sign and stamp by the responsible of the student hostel in Ostend. Of course, students need to respect the “rules and regulations” of the student hostel “de kraal”.

Students need to consider that some travel costs will be made on Tuesday (Travel to Ghent) and Thursday (travel to CNH).
