

Renewed ERASMUS application

The ERASMUS application *Sharing Engineering Know how of Enterprises in the Baltic Sea Region for Improving Quality of Education in Local Universities of Technology (SEKBU)*, handed in in February, was rejected. (Enclosure).

The BALTECH board decided on October 20, 2011 that a revised application should be handed in with the following in mind:

- remarks made by the European Commission should be considered;
- cooperation with industry and new learning methods should be emphasized, whereby identification of a larger number of companies is important;
- the role of BALTECH is to decide the aims of the project and to bring people together.

A meeting for multimedia people and representatives of departments of industrial relations will be arranged in Riga on November 25, 2011.

RTU will engage industry representatives.
